Ecofabulous founder and executive editor Zem Joaquin created the design aesthetic of Harbinger's interior, in partner-ship with Will Wick of Will Wick Design. For this project, she worked with more than 20 manufacturers of eco products to present a home that is beautiful, inviting and incredibly environmentally friendly. Every aspect of the home's design, build, materials and features has been evaluated and received Green Point and LEED certification.

The Harbinger House opens to a series of outdoor living spaces and decks, showcasing an outdoor Whirlpool kitchen and a low-maintenance garden of native and naturalized plants.
